2 Thessalonians

Passages: 2 Thess. 1:5-12

Questions:

- 1) Discuss God's justice in verse 6. How should the Christian respond in light of this passage's context?

- 2) In verse 7, what is the "relief" that God brings to the believer?

- 3) Paul describes the type of judgment that will come to the ungodly in verse 9. Discuss the two outcomes of the reality of this punishment.

- 4) In the first letter to the church in Thessalonica, Paul defined what he meant when he said, "Walk worthy of His calling" (1 Thess 2:9-12). What does Paul mean in 2 Thess 1:12, how does God "make us worthy of His calling?"

- 5) Application: We are not promised an easy journey in this life. How can you personally encourage those in your small group to press on for the sake of Christ and godliness?
