Passages: Luke 3:1-17

Questions:

- 1) John would spend decades waiting to begin his ministry. Many of those years would have been spent out in the wilderness. What lessons from those "wilderness" years do we see in John's ministry? What about your testimony? Has the Lord given you time in the wilderness?

- 2) In 3:4-6, what did John's ministry look like from the Old Testament prophecies?

- 3) By verses 7-9, crowds had gathered to hear John's message. Describe John's message.

- 4) In verses 10-14, John applies different applications to three different demographics. What lessons can we learn from each of them?

- 5) Application: John's purpose was to point to Christ. He does so with great humility while at the same time expressing great boldness. In personal reflection, how has the Lord called you to follow in that pattern of John's testimony?
