Scripture: Luke 10:1-16

Questions:

- 1) What observations can we make about the harvest, the laborers, and the Lord in the first two verses of this chapter?

- 2) The instruction of verses 3-9 is for the 72 disciples sent out. However, there are principles we can glean as we are also “Sent.” Define and discuss some of those principles.

- 3) The first two cursed cities in verses 13-14 witnessed many miracles performed before them. Do miracles produce faith? Why or why not?

- 4) When a messenger speaking of Christ is rejected, who is ultimately the object of the rejection? Why does this matter to us?

- 5) Application: Risk aversion can cause us to be paralyzed in following Christ. Are you obediently following Christ, or are you paralyzed by the fear of the risks in following Him? Prayerfully consider this question.
